Exit Denver International Airport via Pena Blvd. To I-70 West. Exit I-70 to Quebec Street South (exit 278), Continue on Quebec Street to Martin Luther King Blvd, hotel is on the North West corner.

From East: Take I-70 west to Quebec Street South (exit 278), Continue on Quebec Street to Martin Luther King Blvd, hotel is on the North West corner.

From West: Take I-70 east to to Quebec Street South (exit 278), Continue on Quebec Street to Martin Luther King Blvd, hotel is on the North West corner.

From Downtown Denver: Take Stout Street to Martin Luther King Blvd to the corner of Quebec and Martin Luther King Blvd.

BRANDMAN (FORMERLY CHAPMAN) UNIVERSITY

General Information

Chapman University is a 135-year-old independent institution of liberal arts and professional training dedicated to providing a solid foundation of knowledge that enables its graduates to become fully educated persons. The university comprises the Wilkinson College of Arts and Science, the School of Business and Economics, the School of Natural and Applied Science, the School of Communication Arts, the Graduate School of Education, and the School of Music.

History

Chapman traces its roots to Hesperian College, founded at the very hour of Abraham Lincoln's inauguration as the sixteenth U.S. President. Hesperian and several other institutions later merged with California Christian College in Los Angeles. In 1934 the institution was renamed in recognition of its most generous benefactor, C. C. Chapman, a successful real estate investor, rancher, and pioneer Orange County church leader. The college moved to the city of Orange in 1954. In September 1991 the college became Chapman University, further strengthening its commitment to graduate programs, international education, and an innovative undergraduate curriculum.

Academic Centers

In 1958 Chapman offered its first off-campus program at nearby Marine Corps Air Station El Toro—an effort that expanded through the years. Love and Logic Institute, Inc., has had the privilege of working with the Academic Center in Denver, Colorado. Each center maintains a full-time professional staff that provides personal attention throughout the student's work with the school. Personal attention has become the hallmark of Chapman's extended program.

Church Relationship

Chapman's roots are firmly grounded in historical affiliation with the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ). The rich spiritual legacy lives on through Chapman's focus on development of the ethical, spiritual, and intellectual person. Although religious activities are not required, the diversity of religious backgrounds of the university's students reveals the ecumenical spirit that prevails at Chapman.

Accreditation and Membership

Chapman is accredited by and is a member of the Western Association of Schools and Colleges. It is a member of the Independent Colleges of Southern California, the College Entrance Examination Board, the Western College Association, the Association of Independent California Colleges and Universities, the American Council on Education, the American Association of Colleges for Teacher Education, and the Division of Higher Education of the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ). It is also accredited by the Institute of Food Technologists. Its teacher training and credential programs are approved by the California State Department of Education.
