General Information

Brandman University is a 135-year-old independent institution of liberal arts and professional training dedicated to providing a solid foundation of knowledge that enables its graduates to become fully educated persons. In 1958 Brandman offered its first off-campus program at nearby Marine Corps Air Station El Toro—an effort that expanded through the years. Personal attention has become the hallmark of Brandman's extended program.
